- Note 1st. The red lines figures &c. represent the bounds of Weybosset and Broad Streets as laid out by the Town Council in 1737. See Deed Book N^o 9 p 130, also Council Records Book N^o 3 p 117.
- Note 2. The courses and distances marked in blue ink along the Northerly and Westerly sides of the lines a b e d p q w are copied from the deed of Dan^l Mathewson to Joseph Snow, Joseph Snow Jr. Barrelier Richmond and James Brown dated January 10, 1749 B12 p 345.
- Note 3. The courses distances &c. marked in blue ink along the Southerly and Easterly sides of the lines l m n o p q w are copied from the deeds of the grantees in the above deed to each severally dated January 17th, 1749 - B12 pages 346, 347, 348 & 349.
- Note 4. The lines figures &c. in blue ink from r s d l to x & y represent the bounds of Broad St. as surveyed by Benj West in 1724 Plat of Streets N^o 3 p 23.
- Note 5. The green lines figures &c. show the South line of Broad St. from U to V, as surveyed by Daniel Anthony in 1823 and reported in Town Meeting by a committee appointed to cause the Highways to be surveyed & platted. See Book entitled "A Plat of the Town of Providence pages 10 & 11.
