D. 1921 AND BY AND IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF PROVIDENCE NUMBERED 272 APPROVED JUNE 23, 1972 CONDEMNING CERTAIN LAND FOR HIGHWAY PURPOSES

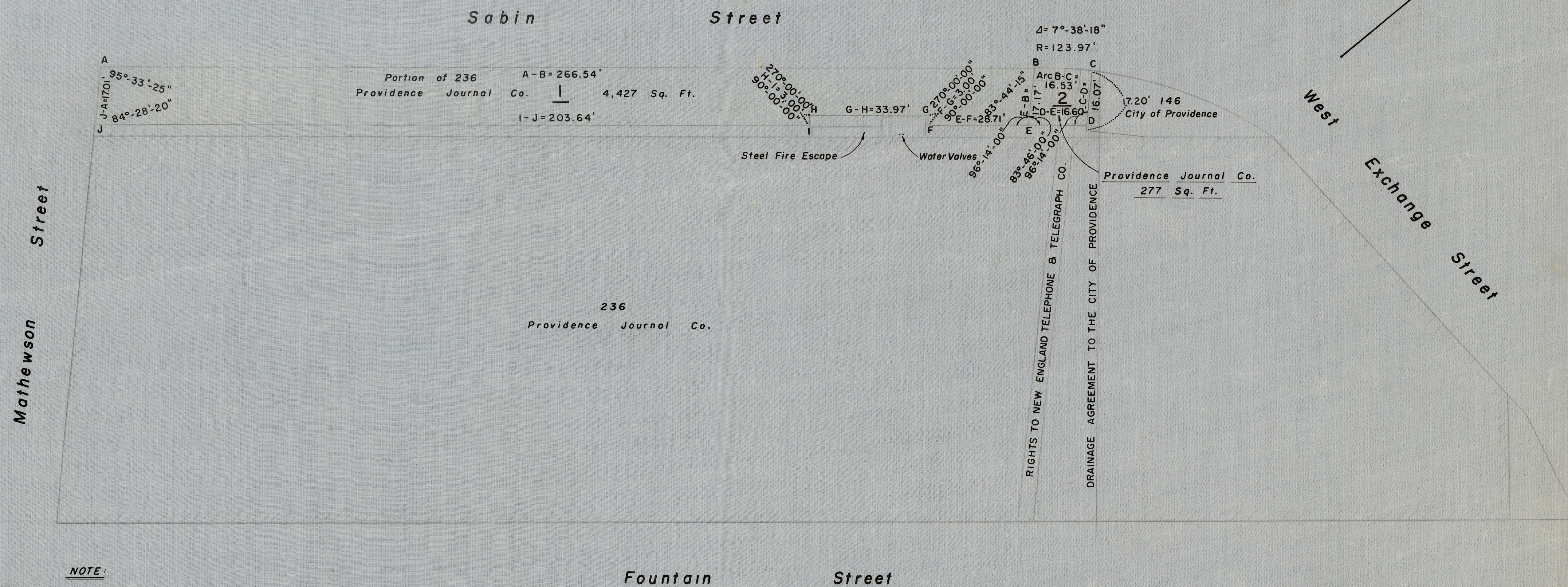

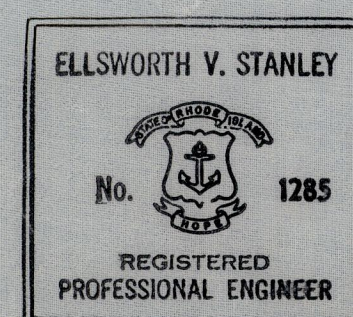
Parcel 2, bounded by B, C, D, E, comprised of 277 sq. ft. is a
