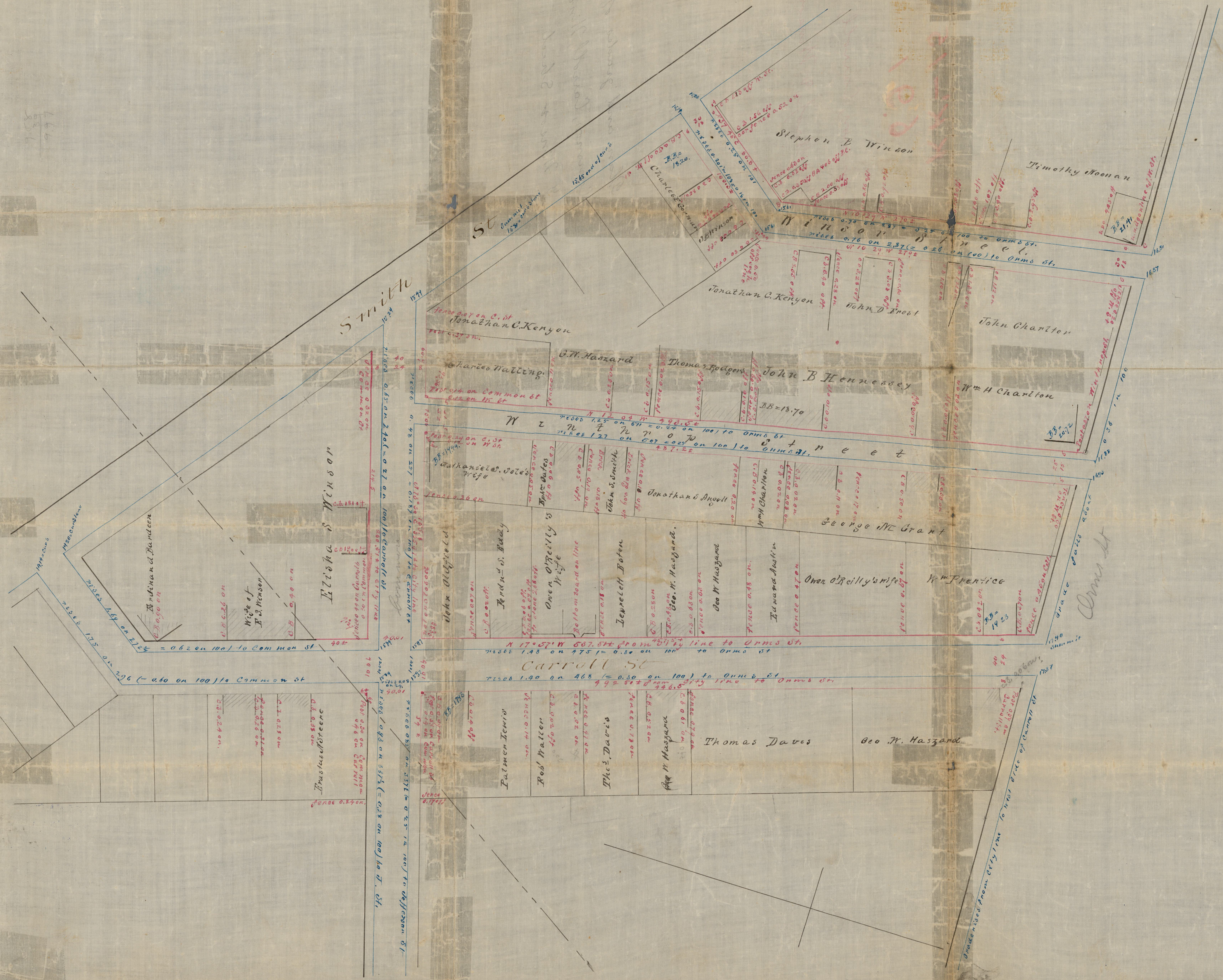

 angles in card lines, denote comparative grades at those points and the *Blue*  
 figures placed on various houses denote comparative elevations of Bottom  
 of Bottom Boards of such houses Grades of each Caroline are described in *Blue* ink  
 "C.B." denotes Corner Boards "B.B." denotes Bottom of Bottom Board ± denotes more or less
