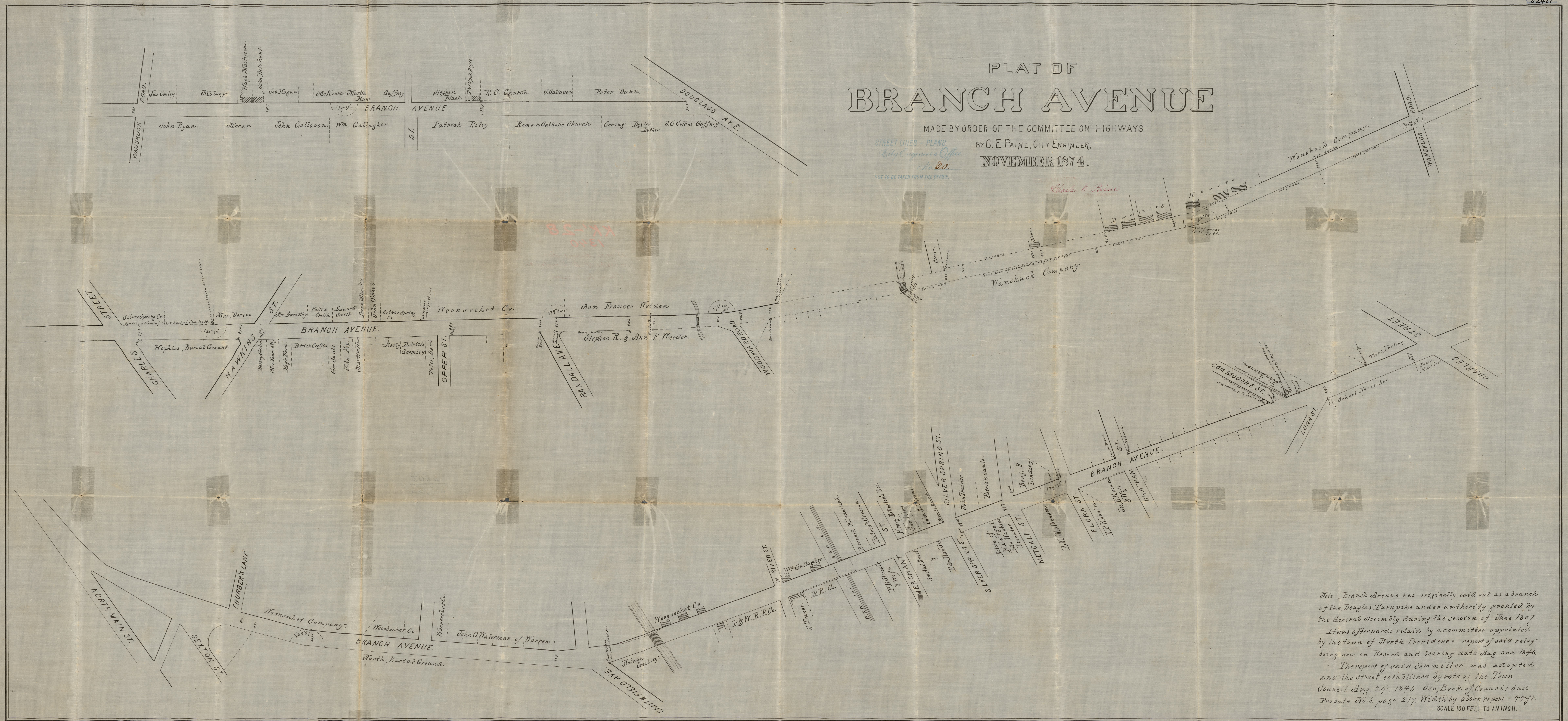


PLAT OF BRANCH AVENUE

This Branch Avenue was originally laid out as a branch of the Douglas Turnpike under an authority granted by the General Assembly during the session of June 1867. It was afterwards resaid by a committee appointed by the town of North Providence report of said relay being now on Record and bearing date Aug. 3rd 1846. The report of said committee was adopted and the street established by vote of the Town Council Aug. 24. 1846. See Book of Council and Private Act page 217. Width by above report = 44 ft.
