

This road and trying place was laid out by order of said Town of North Providence on the third day of September in the year of our Lord and Saviors A.D 1791 by Esqrs Hopkins Peter Randall Joseph Randale and Joseph Hawkins and William Randale all present take notice this road is bounded on the west side and is laid two rod wide except at the largest brook there to be forty feet wide and at Wheaton's corner to be four rods wide and to extend back ten Rod
