Laurel Avenue, as shown hereon was dedicated for highway purposes by two maps, namely "Plat of Laurel Avenue from Arlington Ave. to Taber Ave. &c." and "Plat No. 1 of Land in Providence R.I. belonging to John R. Freeman &c." copies of which can be found in the office of the Recorder of Deeds on Plat Cards #1027 and #1036 respectively.

The lines of Laurel Avenue here indicated, have been fixed in accordance with these plats, the bounds specified on them as land marks, having been located by stations on and offsets measured at right angles to the base line AB, as noted.

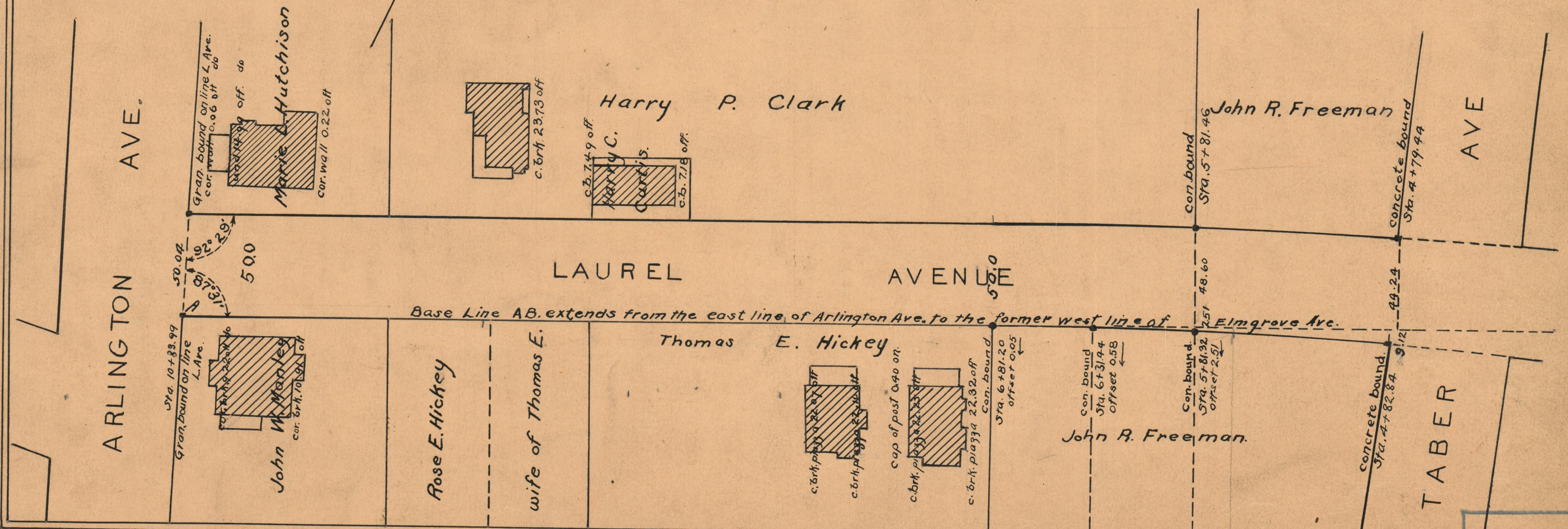
