See Deed Book N^o 60 p. 570-1 This accords with the buildings & fences as they now stand, excepting those on the south side of Stewart St. near Broad St. It should be borne in mind that the Jesse Boynton lot was first enclosed by a fence last spring Wm S. Kaines.
