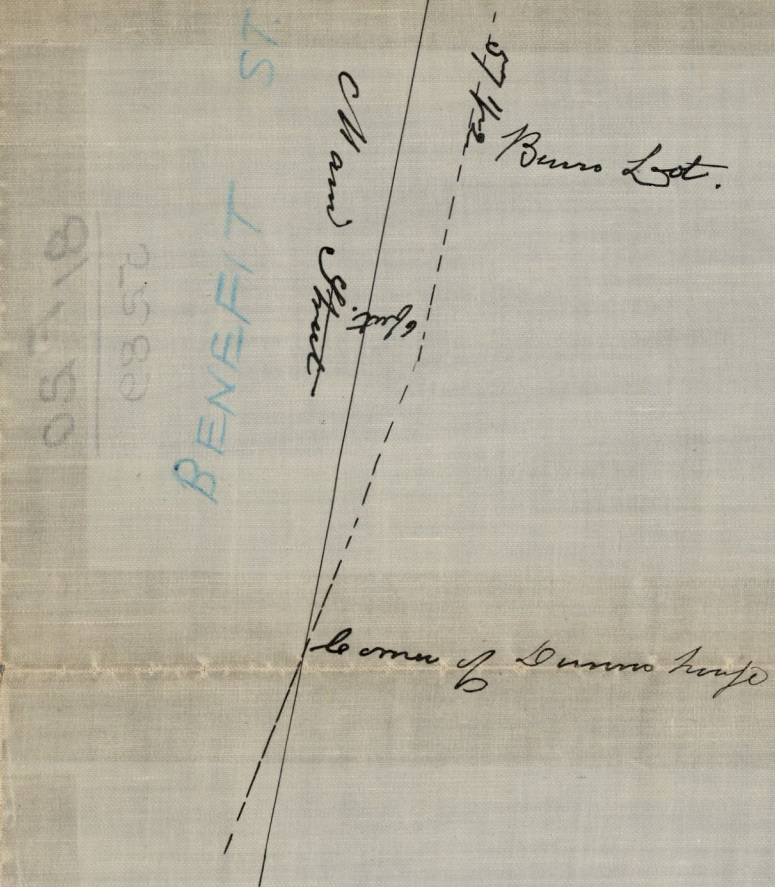
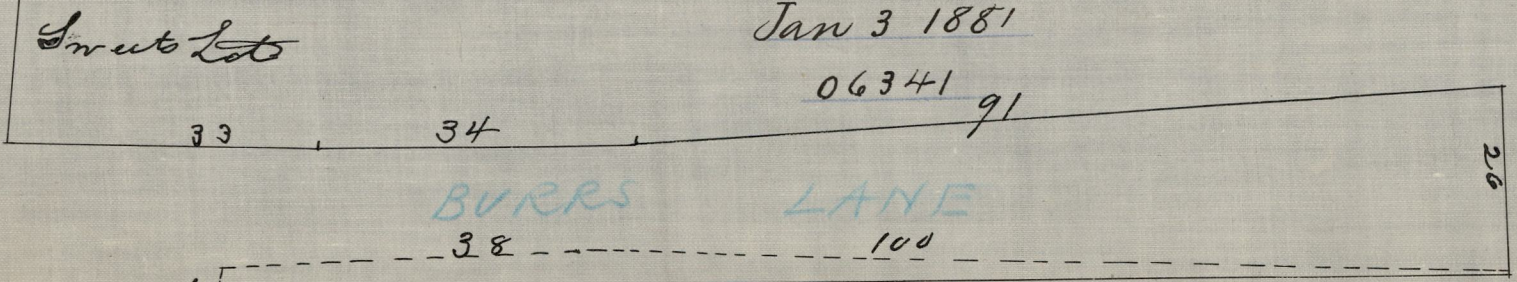

The Committee appointed this present day to take into consideration the Petition of Nathaniel Sweet, Ezekiel Burr, Demmon Burr and others praying that a small piece of Land therein described may be conveyed to said Burr, and the line of the Towns land altered Respectfully Report, that as the alterations proposed is a matter of Accords decision which all the proprietors of the adjoining lands are agreed in and as the land is not useful to the Town in the opinion of your Committee it is expedient that the alteration be made in full line as delineated on the annexed Plat — that seven feet be laid off Westward from a point two feet Southward from the Northwestly corner of said Burr's Lot and nearly parallel with the Line of the Gangway between said Lot and Mr Sweets Shop, and from thence extend Southward on a straight line to the Southwesterly corner of Capt Burrs house and from thence keeping a course to the Easterly line of Benefit Street, provided said Burr will relinquish all his land lying to the Westward of said line and that a conveyance be made to said Burr, of all the land described as aforesaid in front of this lot for the consideration of Thirty Dollars or so condition that he shall not incumber the Wall belonging to the Town by setting Post or planting Trees in front of the land aforesaid
