the Committee appointed this present day to take into consideration the Petition of
Achernah Sweet, Ezekiel Burr, Norton Dunn and others praying that a small piece of
Land therin described may be conveyed to said Burr, and the line of the Town land
altered Respectfully Report, That as the alteration proposed is a matter of accomo-
dation which all the proprietors of the adjoining lands are agreed in and as the
land is not useful to the Town in the opinion of your Committee it is expedient
that the alteration be made in said line as delineated on the annexed plat
— that from the land off Westerly from a point two feet Southerly from
the northerly corner of said Burrs Lot and nearly parallel with the Line
of the Gangway between said Lot and Mr. Sweet's Shop, and from thence ex-
tend Southerly on a straight line to the southerly corner of Capt. Dunn house and
from thence bearing E to the Eastrly line of Benefit Street, provided said Dunn
will relinquish all his land lying to the Westward of said line and that a conveyance be
made to said Burr. of all the land described as aforesaid in front of this lot for the con-
sideration of Thirty Dollars or condition that he shall not inconvenience the Wall
belonging to the Town by setting Post or planting Trees in front of the land aforesaid
all which is submitted by
