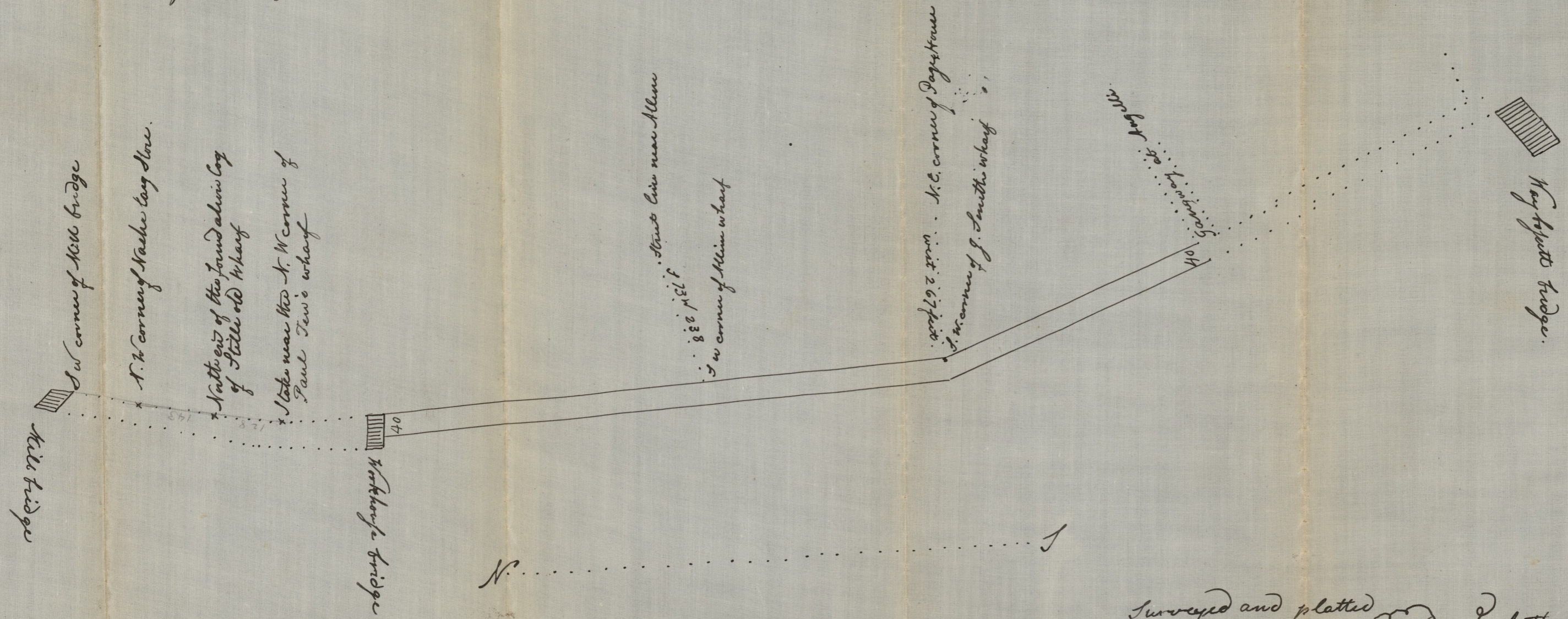


The committee's report in 1782 bounding the east line of the channel is from the South west corner of the Mill bridge to the Northwest corner of Nasher large Store then to the North end of the foundation log of Stillers wharf; then to the Stake near the Northwest corner of Paul Jews wharf, then to the Southwest corner of Zachariah Allen's wharf, then to the South west corner of John Smith's wharf then to the Southwest corner of David Barries Wharf. The following was ascertained in bounding out the public water of the cove in the year 1797 Viz.  
 from the northeast corner of Page House to the Southwest corner of John Smith's wharf -- West 267 feet  
 from the street line a little North of Allen's House and from thence S 73 W 238 feet ranging with the northwest corner of said House to the Southwest <sup>corner</sup> of the <sup>of the</sup> Allen's wharf
