Crescent St. was originally platted on two plats, On the "Plat of House lots in Cranston belonging to A.V. Dike", Wm. J. Harris; Apr. 1853. (Card \$229, Recorder's office), it is shown from Greenwich Road (Reservoir Ave.) to Elmwood (Algonquin) St. The plat is incomplete and does not accurately locate the streets and lots thereon platted. On the "Adelaide Ave. Plan", John Howe, 1889, (card 612), Croscont St. from Elmwood St as aforesaid to Adelaide Ave, is shown and defined by granite bounds. The majority of these bounds are still in position and lines here shown agree with them, the portion of Crescent St. immediately south of Algonquin St. being at right angles there with, as the Dike plat indicates, It is understood that Mr. Howe set the bounds shown on this map south of Sibley St. and these have been used in locating the portion of Croscent St. running northerly from Reservoir Ave. - the location being atright angles to Reservoir Ave as fixed by the Dike plat although the avenue has been relaid since the date of the plat. By a literal interpretation of the Adelaide Ave. plat, Crescent St. running northerly from Alvin St to the nextangle is made 48.07 feet wide.
